#### Clothing

- Rain Jacket

## Dress Code

#### Swim Suits

Modest swimsuits for girls include a complete one-piece or a two-piece tankini that covers the entire stomach at all times. If you do not have a swimsuit that fits these guidelines, you may wear a dark colored t-shirt and shorts. Boys swim trunks must comply to the fingertip rule described under the shorts and pants section.

#### Shirts

Backless shirts, halter-tops, tank tops that are low cut, tight, or expose the stomach are not to be worn. Straps on tank tops must be at least two fingers in width. All shirts must cover your bra entirely.

#### Shorts & Pants

Shorts should be loose fitting and follow the “fingertip” rule: while standing, place arms by side – the shorts hem must fall below your fingertips. Pants and shorts should not have holes above this fingertip line. Wearing leggings as pants is not acceptable. Please bring appropriate shorts to wear over the top of them. Shorts/pants must cover your underwear at all times.

#### Inappropriate Content

Clothing should not display inappropriate content including: profanity, drug, alcohol, tobacco, or satanic references.

#### Footwear

Footwear must be worn at all times at camp (with the exception of inside the cabins). Closed-toed shoes are necessary for participation in electives and field games.
