New website, new video, new building! We as a staff are extremely excited to share updated renderings and vision of the new facility we have been working on with each of you. This newsletter will share a limited amount of information about the new facility, but we sincerely invite you to check out both the new video and website to learn more about this project.

After countless meetings with our architect and engineers, we will be receiving our permit set of drawings in hand in December. We will then apply for a permit for the dining hall in January of 2021. Our goal is to do some excavating and road building during 2021 and have a "blitz" year for 2022 where we pour concrete as soon as the snow leaves (probably around March) and hopefully are dried in by December 2022.
